## Important - before you begin

To take part in the 2022 Primary Results Services you <u>must</u> have an active connection to Aspire Data Exchange.

Please note that the following steps to import 2022 KS1 Results data in FFT Aspire can only be performed by Aspire users with 'Manage Data' administration privileges. They must also have full access to pupil data within their Aspire account role.

If you are not sure about your school role type, level of access or do not have either of these account types, please speak to your school's FFT Aspire administrator.

The file upload function within the 2022 KS1 early results service page will be available and enabled up until **midnight on Friday 29th July 2022**. The service will work in the following windows:

Submission windows	Reports available by
1. Submission by Friday 1st July	Friday 8th July
2. Submission by Friday 15th July	Friday 22nd July
3. Submission by Friday 29th July (service closes)	Mid-August

**NOTE:** The last file submitted within a window will be used to produce the school reports. Changes to the submission can be made up until the deadline dates above but these changes need to be made in the form of an updated file which include any pupils who have previously been included – for example, if you added data for 20 pupils in the first submission and a further 2 within the template need data adding, a file including data for the 22 students should be uploaded to replace the existing one.

FFT will only use the most recently submitted file as of each deadline so the importance of uploading the full 2022 KS1 cohort by the deadline must be stressed.

## Please be aware that this submission to FFT DOES NOT replace the statutory requirement to make a formal submission of KS1 results to the DfE via your LA.

Filename – Name reference for the uploaded file.

**Manage** – uploaded files can be deleted only by the user who uploaded to the service. All users can download a copy of the template that has been uploaded. Users may want to check a file they previously uploaded or download a file, make amendments and reupload to the service

User – Identifies the Aspire user who uploaded the Excel file.

**Date/time** – The date and time which the file upload attempt was made. This is shown in chronological order with most recent file at the top of the list. A tick is shown to identify which file is being processed and used for the schools report.
